## Introduction

### Family History of Orrin Wesley Sides and Cynthia Ann Russell Sides and their descendants

#### **ORRIN WESLEY SIDES**

Born November 11, 1815  
Concord, Cabarrus Co., N.C.  
Marriage Date December 30, 1841  
(Name listed as McLure on Marriage Bonds  
Records, Cabarrus County, P.129)  
Died July 13, 1902  
Burial Rocky Ridge Methodist Church Cemetery,  
Concord, Cabarrus Co., N.C.

Note: Orrin Sides signed his name with an "I" instead of an "E". Noted in his will.

Records found at Cannon Library in Concord, and at the Register of Deeds Office, show in the Marriage Bonds listing from 1793 - 1868, that a Marriage Bond was issued to Orrin McLure and Cynthia Russell for December 30, 1841.

Using information from an earlier Genealogy listing, and talking with some older members of the family, we have determined the following information about Orrin to be true, as verified by records found in Cannon Memorial Library and the Register of Deeds Office.

We have no record of his father and mother's names. We only know that there were 3 brothers who came over from Germany and settled in North Carolina. We do know there are a number of Sides families in the state, but no connected relationships have been proven. We can trace back to Orrin and his family, which we will endeavor to write about in this genealogy listing. We can only hope that someday in the future, someone will find information in an old Bible listing family names, that will tie Orrin to family connections further back. To clarify some of the questions concerning Orrin's name and the marriage bond listed above, in checking records for the name "Sides", we found no listing for Orrin Sides in that time period around 1841. Orrin was 26 at that time and Cynthia was 19.

In the 1850 Census #579 we find that Orrin owned 36 acres of farmland, valued at \$144. He had 30 acres of improved land and 6 acres of unimproved; Livestock owned was valued at \$30. Crops grown were Wheat, Indian Corn and Oats. Family members listed were Orrin, Cynthia, Mary E., John F., and Cyrus E. Twenty years later, The Census of 1870 #127 shows Orrin Sides owns 100 acres of farmland-- 60 acres of improved, 30 acres of woods, 10 acres unimproved. Dollar value of the land is \$500. Crops grown were Wheat, Indian Corn, Oats, and Cotton. Livestock was valued at \$500. Family members listed Orrin, Cynthia, John F., Cyrus E., Alice M., and Charles. These records show the farm to be in the Rocky Ridge community of Cabarrus County, N.C. Since Mary Elizabeth is not listed in the last census, this indicates that she has married and established a home elsewhere.

Therefore, armed with this information, we will proceed to list each child born to Orrin Wesley Sides and Cynthia Ann Russell Sides, and in the coming pages, list all the descendants and their families. This family history will follow the families numerically starting with the first child, giving information about their descendants, and will end with the fourth child, giving information about his descendants.

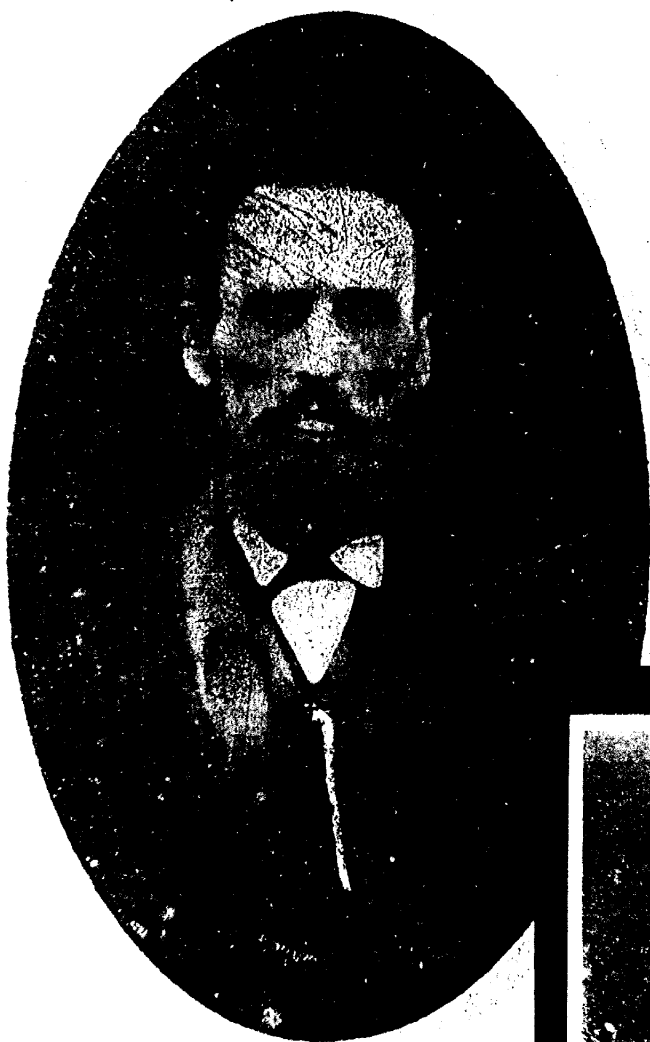

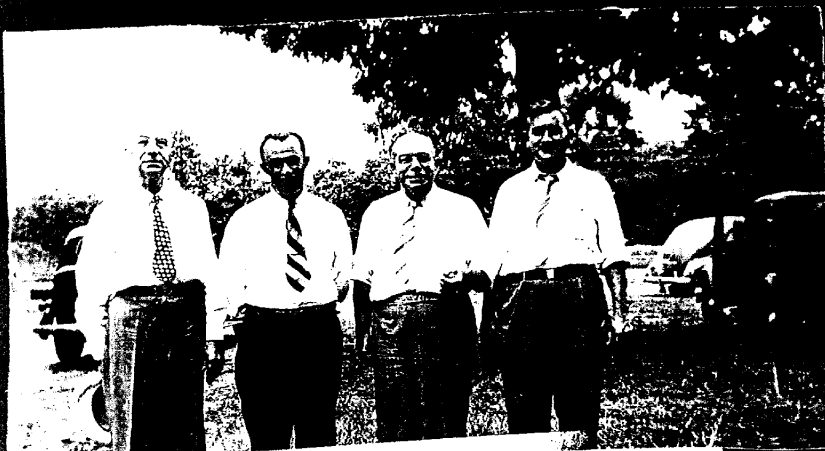




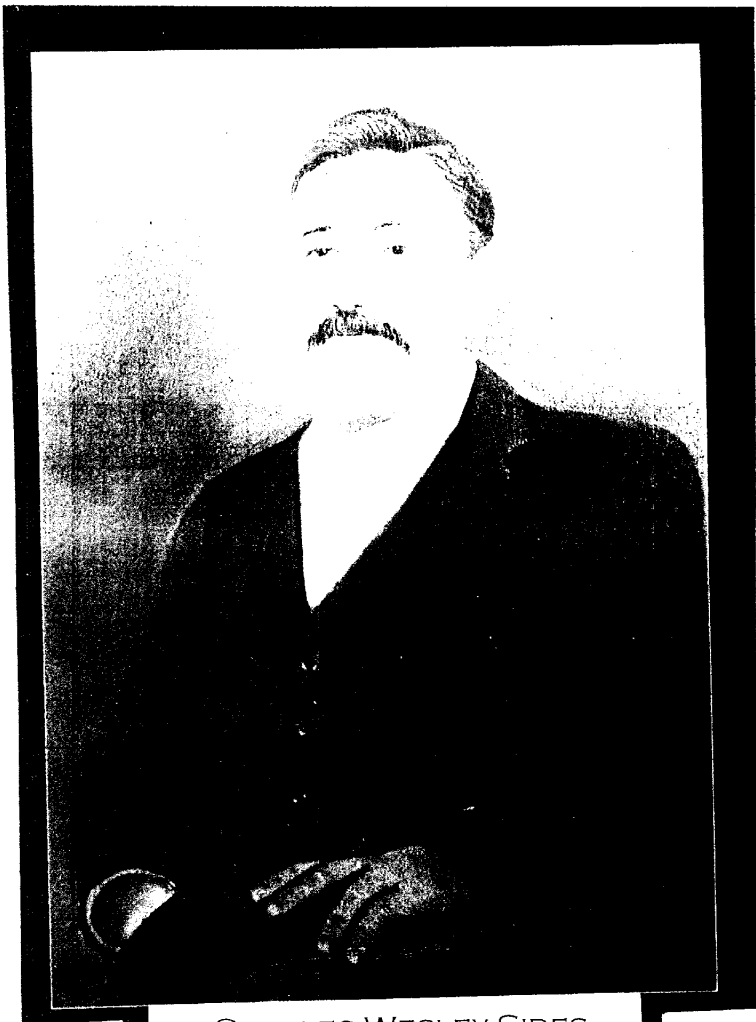

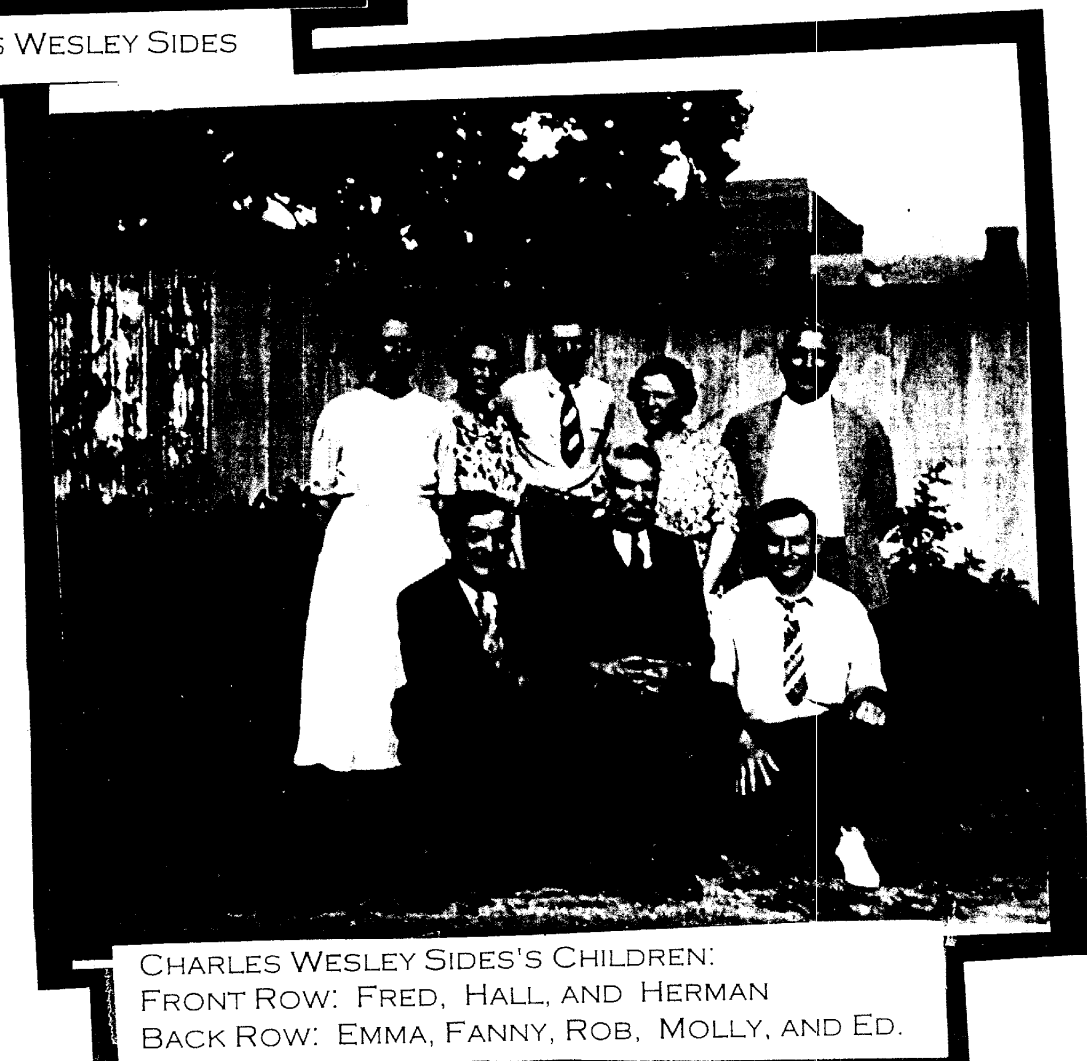
